Regarding the following King Plastic Corporation's products and the State of California Proposition 65 reporting requirements and list dated January 3, 2020.

**Polyethylene – King StarBoard® Family, King DuraStyle®, King MediGrade®, King ColorBoard®, King ColorCore®, King CuttingBoard®, King FlameShield, King MicroShield®, King Plasti-Bal®, King Plasti-Shield®, King HyPact®, King KPC HDPE, and King KPC LDPE**

This product does not contain any Proposition 65 chemicals.

**Polypropylene – King KPC Polypropylene**

This product does not contain any Proposition 65 chemicals.

**ABS – King KPC ABS**

While acrylonitrile, butadiene, and styrene; components in ABS, are listed separately on California's Proposition 65 list of chemicals that it has determined cause cancer and/or reproductive effects, the compound ABS is not listed.

**King PipeGrade®**

While carbon black is listed in California's Proposition 65 list of chemicals, it is listed as airborne, unbound particles of respirable size. The carbon black as it exists in King PipeGrade® is not in this form; not airborne, bound to the base resin, and not of respirable size.
